- Surveys Integral to Measuring, Understanding, and Reporting on Selected Dimensions of Undergraduate Life
- Focus on Cognitive, Behavioral, and Affective Transition to the University

University of California Undergraduate Experiences Survey (UCUES)

- Census survey administered every other year by UC Office of the President
 - Campus coordination by UCSD IR Office-timing, logistics, publicity, recruitment
- 21 AAU Non-UC Campuses also use Core modules (SERU)
- Over 9,500 respondents for San Diego campus (2018)
- Campus partners are key to improving response rates:
 - Berkeley response rate: 41%
 - Irvine response rate: 37%
 - San Diego response rate: 33%







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













Homeless during Winter break - yes





Introduction

- Administered at select R1 universities across the nation
- 5 modules covering major aspects of the graduate student experience
 - Core
 - International student experience
 - Professional development
 - Health and well-being
 - Incivility and harassment
- 7,292 students registered Spring 2019 were invited to take the survey
- 2,472 consented to participate = 34% response rate

- Overall graduate experience
- Academic Experience
 - Experience with advisor
 - Research experience
- Social Experience
 - Social interactions
- Inclusion in UCSD community
 - By faculty, staff, fellow students, students instructed




Satisfaction with Overall Experience

Level of Agreement: I am satisfied with my overall graduate experience at UCSD




Quality of Academic Experience, Social Experience, Inclusion


